1. INTERPRETATION

1.1. In this Cookies Policy ("this policy"), the following terms will have the following meaning:

- 1.1.1. "**Us**", "**we**", "**our**", "**Owls**", "**Owls Daycare**" means LITTLE SCIENTISTS CLUB LIMITED with company registration number 10987305 and registered office address of 18 College Parade, Salusbury Road, Queens Park, London, United Kingdom, NW6 6RL.
- 1.1.2. "**You**", "**your**", "**user**" means the person or persons visiting our website and/or using our website.
- 1.1.3. "**Website**", "**site**" means the Owls Daycare website with address: www.owlsdaycare.co.uk and www.owlsdaycare.com.

2. GENERAL

2.1. The Owls Daycare website is operated by us. We use cookies on our website for a number of reasons. This policy described how we use cookies on our website. Please make sure you read this policy in full and understand this policy before continuing to use our website. 3. WHAT ARE COOKIES?

3.1. A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that is downloaded on to your computer when you visit a website. Cookies are used by many websites and can do a number of things, which include, remembering a user's device, remembering a user's preferences, recording what user's put in their shopping basket, and counting the number of people looking at a website or particular page on a website.

3.2. There are two types of cookies, session (Transient) cookies and Persistent (Permanent or Stored) cookies:

3.2.1. **Session (Transient) cookies:** These cookies are erased when you close your browser, and do not collect information from your computer. They typically store information in the form of a session identification that does not personally identify the user.

3.2.2. **Persistent (Permanent or Stored) cookies:** These cookies are stored on your hard drive until they expire (i.e. they are based on a set expiration date) or until you delete them. These cookies are used to collect identifying information about the user, such as Web surfing behaviour or user preferences for a specific site.

4. WHAT COOKIES DO WE USE ON OUR WEBSITE?

4.1. We have listed the types of cookies we use on our website below:

4.1.1. Cookies that are strictly necessary:

4.1.1.1. These cookies are essential for us to ensure you are able to move around our website and use the features available on our web pages. We would not be able to supply you with the goods and/or services we offer without having and using these cookies.

4.1.2. Performance cookies:

4.1.2.1. We use these cookies to collect information about how our visitors use our website. For example, which page is visited most often, how long visitors stay on a certain page, how many pages are viewed by visitors etc. These cookies do not collect information that would allow us identify an individual. The information collected by these cookies are aggregated and are anonymous. We use the information collected by the cookies to make improvements and inform changes to our website.

4.1.3. Functional cookies:

4.1.3.1. We sue these cookies to ensure our website functions as effectively and efficiently as possible. These cookies allow our website to remember choices you make including your preferred language to display text, the region you

are in etc. The information these cookies gather allows us to enhance our website and provide users with personalised features. The information these cookies collect may be anonymised and they cannot track your browsing activity on other websites.

4.1.4. Google Analytics cookies

4.1.4.1. We use these cookies to gather information on how our visitors use our website. We use this information to inform changes or improvements we make to our website or its functionality. The information collected by these cookies is anonymous and it includes, number of visitors to our site, which pages users came from immediately prior to visit our site (e.g. referrals from other sites), the pages that are visited, how long particular pages are visited for etc. For further information on Google Analytics please visit: <http://www.google.com/analytics/learn/privacy.html>.
